Patryk Pleskot, PhD (born in 1980) – historian, graduate from Warsaw University and Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales in Paris. He was also studying at University of Nancy. Scholar of the Foundation of Polish Science, Ministry of National Education and the government of French Republic.

Since 2007 he works at the Institute of National Remembrance in Warsaw. Area of his scientific interest consists of French history and historiography, political, cultural and social history of communist Poland, as well as the activity of Polish diaspora after 1945 and the activity of the Polish counter-espionage apparatus.

He is an author and co-author of more than 10 books and more than 100 articles, i.a. *Ideology of French Communist Party toward the collapse of the URSS* (2006), *Television in the daily life of Poles in the 60's* (2007); *The scientific school of survival. Polish Academy of Science in Paris from 1978 to 2004* (2008); *The hampered Academy. Polish Academy of Sciences in the documents of security apparatus 1967–1987* (t. 1: 2009, t. 2: 2012); *Intellectual neighbours. Relations between Polish historians and the Annales mouvement from 1945 to 1989* (2010), *Solidarity, West and... Snakes. Polish security apparatus toward emigration structures of Solidarity 1981–1989* (2011), *Generation 82/90. The Polish Independent Student's Union of Warsaw University, 1982–1989* (2011); *Niewiadomski: to kill the President* (2012).

Access and Parking

-  **Bike** The best bike access is via the pathway running along the Parramatta River on the campus side.
-  **Walk** Parramatta South campus is located a 5 minute walk from the Victoria Road bus stop.
-  **Drive** Entrance to the campus is via Victoria Road. All vehicles parked on a UWS campus must display a valid UWS parking permit. To avoid being issued a parking fine visitors must purchase a 'Pay and Display' permit available for purchase at any of the parking permit machines located in the parking areas of each UWS campus.
